Marriage Fraud victims will be pursuing Class Lawsuit against Canadian Government.

Dear Editor,

Mr. Sam Benet, the President of

Canadians Against Immigration Fraud (CAIF) announced that the organization would be pursuing a class lawsuit against Citizenship and Immigration Canada (CIC) and Canada Border Service Agency (CBSA) for not taking appropriate action and appropriately investigating into marriage fraud complaints.

With the rapid increasing cases of marriage frauds in Canada, Honorable Roy Cullen is among the few MPs in Ontario, who attended a public meeting held on July 6th 2008 organized by CAIF.

He stated that his office is exceptionally familiar with marriage fraud issues and the numbers of complaints are staggering. He has many alternative solutions to prevent this crisis from plaguing the Canadian society furthermore pointing out the challenges the law makers are encountering when making amendments to the existing laws.

He does support the idea of class lawsuit to bring awareness and to gain support from the members of parliament and general public. 4. For the purposes of these Regulations, a foreign national shall not be considered a spouse, a common-law partner, a conjugal partner or an adopted child of a person if the marriage, common-law partnership, conjugal

partnership or adoption is not genuine and was entered into primarily for the purpose of acquiring any status or privilege under the Act. SOR/2004-167, s. 3(E).

MR. Gurbax Malhi, the representative of Bramalea—Gore—Malton member of parliament has been working on this issue and supports the CAIF.

Mr. Benet reported that Canadians Against Immigration Fraud has received correspondences from the minister of immigration office that they would like to have a meeting with the representative of the CAIF organization members.
